

Green Screen



Green screen photography is where a subject is photographed in front of a green background. The image is then transferred to a computer where the software replaces the background in the image with a selected scene thus giving the appearance of the subject standing in front of the selected scene.



Additional advancements in photographic technology allow us to also add a foreground layer to the scene, bringing depth and realism to the final image.

Specification

Prints per hour.

This is very much dependant on how quickly the guests get into position, however just using one system we are able to process 100 prints per hour.

Print Size

We can print out onto any size up to A3 (297 mm x 420 mm). The most common sizes are A4 and A5.



Site Requirements

Space

This very much depends on how much of the subjects body is required to be in the photograph. For a full body shot, which requires the maximum amount of space, an area of 4 metres x 4 metres would be required. This would also house the operator with computer and printers.

Power

2 x 13 amp sockets.
